# Medicaid Type B Transfer Agency

The Work Normally Done by APD Offices Medicaid, SNAP, APS and Foster Home Licensing

The allocation is determined statewide

- Caseload Forecasting
- Workload Model (side note: HB3189)

Once the money comes in the door

- The perk of local control
- Where the Councils can provide input

### Area Agency on Aging

Oregon Project Independence (OPI) Older Americans Act (OAA) and

Funding is determined in two primary ways:

- Federal: Based on state populations of older individuals
- State: Base rate, land area, population (not a straight people 60+ number)

Impact of Councils' input:

- Continued advocacy for local control and flexibility
- Identification of priorities for additional funds
- Oversight of contracts
