Cascades West Training Center Driver Training Guidelines

All participants and trainer will strictly adhere to the 6 foot social distancing guidelines with properly arranged seating and class limits to allow for a safe learning environment. Each person will need to use hand sanitizer upon entry to the training room and again each time they leave and return. In addition, face coverings must be worn during class by participants and instructor with the exception of briefly removing face covering to perform breathing during CPR hands on practice with each participant having his/her own sanitized manikin and maintaining social distancing guidelines.

Hands on activities will be individual in nature and no physical contact with another participant or instructor will be required during the First Aid/CPR portion of class; Passenger Assistance Safety and Sensitivity will exclude partner exercises and provide hands on wheelchair securement training with an empty wheelchair, gloves, and sanitizer to be used after each person.

Messaging will be sent out to providers and participants regarding social distancing and face covering requirements. Participants who are unable to wear a face covering will be required to postpone class until such a time as they are able to wear a face covering or it is no longer required without fees or penalties. All participants will sign a declaration at the start of training each day to state that he/she has not been experiencing flu like symptoms within the last 72 hours or been in contact with someone known to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
